We need one volunteer to audit the books over the summer. If you are interested, please contact **Sharon Long**.

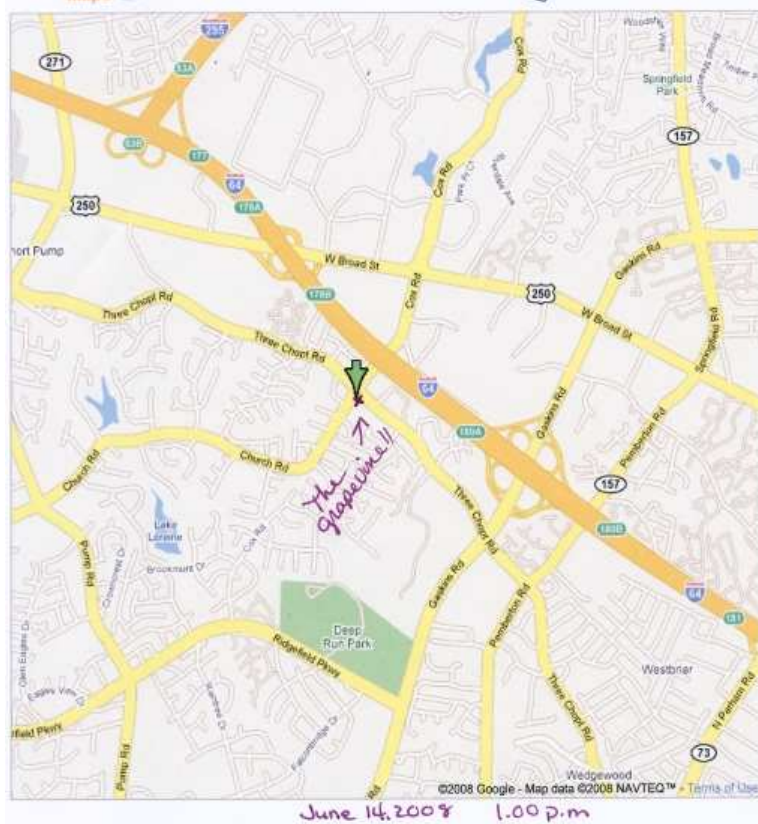
Show

May 10, 2008
